Singapore Cooperation Programme

CLDP provides training and consultative services to lawmakers, regulators, judges, lawyers and educators, seeking assistance in the evaluation, revision and implementation of evolving commercial legal systems necessary oversight using best practices.

CLDP has more than 20 years of experience working with developing and transitional countries to strengthen economic environments through a broad and flexible approach to commercial law technical

assistance. This has created an opportunity for the United States to build stronger bilateral relationships, while increasing economic apportunity for itself and its partners.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This workshop will focus on current issues in competition, investment, and securities law and the overlap and tension between regulations of those areas. Competition law is increasingly becoming an international issue, but the legal frameworks that govern competition are mainly domestic. Healthy competition is seen as a sign by foreign investors that a market is sophisticated enough for them to invest.

Securities regulators require information that is of use to Competition authority investigators during the merger and ecquisition process and when foreign investors purchase large amounts of stock. The overlap in jurisdiction is becoming increasingly important with the increase in cross-border competition and the growth of the global investment market.

This workshop will act as a train-the-trainers program. Participants will gain a better grasp of procedural fairness, and issues in International cooperation involving anti-trust.

COURSE OUTLINE

The course will cover the following areas:

- Procedural Fairness in Competition Investigations and Decisions
- Promoting a Good Investment Through Sound Competition Policy and Competition Law Enforcement
- International Cooperation Among Enforces in Cross-Border Competition Investigations
- Administrative and Judicial Capacity for Competition Law
- Inter-governmental Cooperation between Securities Regulators and Competition Authorities
